

Atlanta NETCONF Interoperability Testing Event

Confidentiality Agreement

This Agreement is intended to protect the participants in these tests, and to ensure that any information relating to such tests is used solely to further the purpose of interoperability. It must be signed by an authorized representative of each organization participating in the testing event.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

As a condition of participating in the NETCONF Interoperability Testing event organized by IETF volunteers in Atlanta, Nov. 3-4 2012, the organization identified below ("Participant") agrees that any information about the performance, compatibility or test results relating to the products of any participant ("Information") is the confidential and proprietary property of the respective owners of such products. In order to protect the confidentiality of the Information, the Participant agrees that it will not disclose any Information or report any problems encountered by any specific (named) participant during the Atlanta NETCONF Interoperability Testing Event to any non-participant of the Atlanta NETCONF Interoperability Testing Event. This does not restrict the Participants rights to disclose information about implementation(s) of the Participant as long as no other specific participants are named in such information disclosures. The Participant further agrees not to use the Information for its own benefit or for any purpose other than testing interoperability among the products.

The confidentiality obligations of the Participant herein will not apply beyond one (1) year from the last day of the NETCONF Interoperability Testing Event, nor will such obligations apply to any Information which (a) is now or hereafter becomes generally known or available in the public domain through no fault of the Participant, (b) is knowingly furnished to others by its owner without restrictions on disclosure, (c) is received from a third party not under obligation to treat the Information as confidential or (d) is independently developed by the Participant.

Source traffic data used during the Atlanta NETCONF Interoperability Testing event may be derived from actual traffic, in order to provide a realistic test environment. Participant agrees that neither the source traffic data, nor any data derived from the source traffic data, may be used for any purpose other than testing interoperability among the tested products, and that no such data will be taken from the premises, either during or after the event. Confidentiality of traffic data is perpetual, and not subject to any limitation on confidentiality obligations in the paragraph above.

ACCEPTANCE

The Participant expressly agrees to the obligation of confidentiality described above.
